- I will respect ALL Skate Park visitors, users and staff at ALL times.

- I will NOT use graffiti or damage any property at the Skate Park.
- I will use the required safety gear at ALL times. Helmet, both elbow pads and both kneepads.
- My skates/skate board will be kept in good condition at ALL times.

- I acknowledge that in-line skating and skateboarding require strenuous physical activity and endurance. I also understand the risks and dangers associated with participation in these activities, which include, but are not limited to, falls, muscle strains, cuts, bruises and broken bones. The risk of injury from these activities is significant, including the potential for permanent paralysis and death, and while the particular rules equipment and personal discipline may reduce this risk; the risk of serious injury does exist.
- I certify that I, to the best of my knowledge have no physical, mental or emotional condition which might be aggravated by this activity, which might in any way inconvenience or endanger staff or participants, or which might impair my ability to participate in and withstand all possible in-line and skateboarding activity.
- I will obey all rules, regulations and directives but forth by the Rye Recreation Department and the person in charge, and will assist by informing and/or calling to the attention of the person in charge, any situation which might result in injury.
- I acknowledge the rigors of these activities connected with in-line skating and skateboarding, and in consideration for being accepted as a participant in this program, I hereby accept ALL responsibility for taking care of myself while participating in this program. I agree that Rye Recreation, their agents, employees and volunteers will not be liable for any damages or injuries directly or approximately caused by any act, happening or event.

## ***Rules of the Skateboard/In-Line Skating Facility - Rye Recreation***

- All participants must register and fill out required paperwork. (If under 18, a parent waiver is required.)
- All skaters must wear a helmet (buckled), elbow pads and kneepads while skating. Hand guards are recommended
- All skaters are expected to act in an orderly, safe and considerate manner while in the Skate Park.
- No “snaking”. Reckless or dangerous skaters will be requested to leave the premises. Those who have more than once offense can have their registration temporarily or permanently revoked.
- All injuries, whether major or minor, are to be reported to the supervisor immediately. In case of serious injury, do not move the injured person; notify the supervisor immediately.
- Any persons caught skating before or after hours will have their privileges revoked and any monies paid will not be refunded.
- Daily participants and guests of permit holders are permitted as long as a parent/guardian is on hand to sign the waiver and pay associated fees.
- The playing of a radio is not permitted.
- Shirts must be worn at all times.
- NO smoking, NO profanity and NO loitering in the skate park at anytime
- Minimum age for participants in 8 years old unless accompanied by an adult.

### ***Park Dismissal***

- Any participant not following the rules of the skate park will be asked to leave the park immediately
- First time offenders will receive a verbal warning; second violation will result in suspension of park use
- A written report for each violation will be submitted to the Recreation Department
- If a suspension occurs, a refund WILL NOT be given, and will be reviewed prior to the start of the next season.
- If any member of the skate park club is found in the park when the park is not open, will have their privileges revoked.

### ***Park Hours***

- The Rye Recreation Department will schedule hours of operation
- Rye Recreation reserves the right to close the skate park for any reason
