Councilwoman Larr made a motion, seconded by Councilwoman Cunningham and unanimously carried, to adopt the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to amend Chapter 197, *Zoning*, of the Code of the City of Rye for the Purpose of Regulating the Scale, Size and Height of Residences, and

WHEREAS, it is now desired to call a public hearing on such proposed new law, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Rye as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 20 of the Municipal Home Rule Law and the Charter of the City of Rye, New York, a public hearing will be held by the

Council of said City on July 16, 2003 at 8:00 P.M. at City Hall, Boston Post Road, in said City, for the purpose of affording interested persons an opportunity to be heard concerning such proposed local law.

Section 2. Such notice of public hearing shall be in substantially the following form:
