

**APPROVED MINUTES** of the Special Meeting of the City Council of the City of Rye held in City Hall on August 30, 2006 at 7:35 A.M.

1. Pledge of Allegiance

Mayor Otis called the meeting to order and invited the Council to join in the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. Roll Call

Mayor Otis asked the City Clerk to call the roll; a quorum was present to conduct official city business.

3. Adoption of the 2006/2007 tax levy and tax rate for the Rye Neck Union Free School District

Councilman Seitz made a motion, seconded by Councilman Ball, to adopt the following resolution:

**WHEREAS**, the lawful authorities of the Rye Neck Union Free School District have fixed the amount of taxes to be raised for said district for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006 and ending June 30, 2007, in the amount of \$26,845,234 a 8.25% increase over the 2005/2006 levy, and have duly apportioned to the parts of said district lying within the City of Rye, the amount of \$7,650,158 and they have established a tax rate in the amount of \$528.51252 per \$1,000 taxable assessed value on Homestead property, a decrease of \$0.5868 (0.11%) over the 2005/2006 tax rate, and a tax rate in the amount of \$684.76278 per \$1,000 taxable assessed value on Non-Homestead property, a \$1.5174 (0.22%) decrease over the 2005/2006 tax rate, for the levy of the aforesaid School District taxes for the parts of said district lying within the City of Rye;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in pursuance with the relevant provisions of the City Charter, you are hereby commanded to collect the taxes in the amount of

\$7,650,158 from the part of the Rye Neck Union Free School District lying within said City, at the Homestead rate of \$528.51252 per \$1,000 assessed value and the Non-Homestead rate of \$684.76278 per \$1,000 taxable assessed value, as fixed by the City Council.
