Subject: **BURGLARY ARREST JANUARY 4, 2011**

Members of this Department assisted in a Burglary arrest in the Village of Rye Brook on Monday, January 4, 2011.

At approximately 5:45 P.M., the Rye Brook Police Department transmitted a report of a Burglary in progress at a residence on Woodland Avenue. A neighbor had observed what appeared to be two males breaking into the house. Members of this Department who were deployed on enhanced patrol to address the current burglary pattern responded, along with Port Chester Police Department units, and set up a perimeter. Lieutenant Robert Falk coordinated deployment and requested the response of a canine unit from the Harrison Police Department. Two males were located in the house and were taken into custody.

At this time, this incident appears to be unrelated to the pattern currently under investigation by this Department; however, it was an example of rapid, coordinated response, sound tactics, and interagency coordination that led to an excellent arrest.
