CLAIMS

A notice of claim has been filed by Virginia McGrane of 599 Midland Avenue, as mother and natural guardian of Caroline Williford and Virginia McGrane individually. The notice states that Caroline Williford suffered injuries when she slipped and fell on the ice on the sidewalk on the Boston Post Road in front of Christ's Church Nursery School. The claim has been forwarded to our insurance carrier.

LITIGATION

JEFFREY LITTLE and SUSAN LITTLE, as parents and natural guardians of CHARLES LITTLE, an infant, and JEFFREY LITTLE and SUSAN LITTLE, individually v. CITY OF RYE and WILLIAM R. CONNORS

A summons and verified complaint was served on the City in connection with an accident that took place on February 1, 2010. A notice of claim was previously filed in April 2010. The complaint has been forwarded to our insurance carrier.

BEAVER SWAMP BROOK – (DEC Administrative proceeding)

Harrison has submitted its comments back to the Administrative Law Judge on the draft permit and indicated that they had no issues with the conditions imposed on the permit. The City has until April 22nd to comment on the draft permit or raise any new issues.

SCHUBERT V. CITY OF RYE, ET AL.

Plaintiffs' 30-day statutory time period for filing a Notice of Appeal in this matter is still running.

R.B. CONWAY V. CITY OF RYE

The trial has been calendared for September 2011.

DELLI PAOLI V. ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS

The attorney for plaintiff has requested that the reconsideration of the application by the Zoning Board of Appeals be adjourned to the Board's May meeting.

SHEW v. CITY OF RYE

The City served its reply papers in further support of its Motion to Dismiss and in Opposition to Plaintiff's Motion for Leave to File a Late Notice of Claim. The matter is now fully submitted.

MOLLOY v. PLANNING COMMISSION

Petitioner's Appellants appeal still pending.

PANETTA v. PLANNING COMMISSION

Petitioner's reply papers are due in early April.

SCHUBERT v. PLANNING COMMISSION, et al

Plaintiffs' 30-day statutory time period for filing a Notice of Appeal in this matter is still running.
