COVID-19 PROTOCOL RELATED TO PROGRAMMING AT RYE RECREATION, RYE GOLF CLUB AND THE RYE MUNICIPAL BOAT BASIN

Rye Recreation

Scenario 1

If a participant's school has closed due to COVID-19, any student at the school will not be permitted to attend any Rye Recreation activity taking place at the Rye Recreation facilities whether such activity is run through a separate programmer (e.g., Authorized Sport Groups, Facility Rentals; Rye Reads, Rye Library Learning Lounge or other authorized user group) or directly through Rye Recreation (e.g., Afterschool programs or Recess, etc.). Such suspension shall cease when the school reopens and the student is permitted to go back to school.

Example: Student A attends Midland Elementary School and Midland closed due to COVID-19. All students in attendance at Midland will not be permitted to return to the Rye Recreation facilities until Midland is reopened. Please Note: In this example, students at Osborn and Milton will be permitted to attend the Rye Recreation activity if Midland was the only elementary school closed.

Scenario 2

If a student is directed to quarantine by the school (or has tested positive for COVID-19), such student and any member of the household shall not be permitted to attend any Rye Recreation activity taking place at the Rye Recreation facilities whether such activity is run through a separate programmer (e.g., Authorized Sport Groups, Facility Rentals; Rye Reads, Rye Library Learning Lounge or other authorized user group) or directly through Rye Recreation (e.g., Afterschool programs or Recess, etc.). Such suspension shall cease when the student/participant is able to return to school or is otherwise not required to quarantine any longer.

Example: Student A was notified by the School (or other entity) that Student A was exposed to a COVID-19 positive person and is directed to quarantine. Student A (and any member of Student A's family) is not permitted to return to the Rye Recreation activity until such quarantine is lifted.

Scenario 3

If an individual (participant, adult participant, parent, coach, staff member) or any member of their household tests positive for COVID-19, such individual(s) is not permitted to attend any Rye Recreation activity taking place at the Rye Recreation facilities whether such activity is run through a separate programmer (e.g., Authorized Sport Groups, Facility Rentals; Rye Reads, Rye Library Learning Lounge or other authorized user group) or directly through Rye Recreation (e.g., Afterschool programs or Recess, etc.) until such student is permitted to return to school (by virtue of quarantining for 14 days or a doctor's note indicating such student is no longer contagious).

Rye Golf Club/Rye Boat Basin

Please note: these are protocols as effective as of 10/14/2020 and are subject to change based on the information available to us at the time of the incident/type of exposure.

No member/slip holder shall be permitted at Rye Golf Club or the Rye Municipal Boat Basin if he/she or any member of his/her household has tested positive for COVID-19 or has been directed to quarantine. Any such member/slip holder may return to the Rye Golf Club or Rye Municipal Boat Basin after the 14-day quarantine period has expired or with the clearance from a doctor that he/she is not contagious.
